Dear Parents and Carers,

<u>Mobile Phones in School</u> - If your child brings a mobile phone to school, please remind them to hand the phone to the office when they arrive. If a phone is discovered in your child's bag or locker, we will ask that a parent collects it from school rather than hand it back to your child directly. We will call you and notify you of this in case you wish to collect it at the end of the school day rather than it remain at school overnight.

Events this week - It's been another busy week with some lovely opportunities to join with other schools. On Monday, our Year 6 children joined with Year 6 children from other Church Schools at the Cathedral for the Diocesan Leavers' Service. Yesterday, we hosted the Goodwood Area Schools (GAS) sports event here. The children not only competed well in their events but were so supportive of each other, no matter where in a race they finished. Thank you to Miss Jennings for organising and running the event. Thank you also to the children who helped out with setting up and clearing up as well as to the other staff who supported the event.

<u>Staffing News</u> - There will be a few changes to where some members of staff are working in September as we say goodbye to Mrs Martin and following the departure of Mrs Squires. Mr Rogers has also made the decision to reduce his hours.

Squirrel Class - Mrs Whittle, Mrs Pendle (mornings and cover for Mrs Whittle's planning time) and we welcome Mrs Ford as Teaching Assistant. She comes with a wealth of experience with this age group. Sports day

- All children need to come to school dressed for sports day (<u>We would like the children to wear the same colour T shirt as their house team please</u>. If your child doesn't own the right colour, please can they wear a white t-shirt (a normal school top is fine). Long hair should be tied back and earrings removed or taped over. The children will need their water bottles and a sunhat.
- We will open the side gate at 1.15pm and close it just before 1.30pm. After this time no one will be able to enter the school site as everyone will be out on the field. We also ask that once you have arrived that you stay on site until the end of the sports and a member of staff has re opened the gate. If there is an emergency and you need to leave, please find a member of staff on the field who can make sure you are able to leave.
- We ask that you sit on the opposite side of the track to the school. You might want to bring a blanket or chair to sit on.
- During first part of the afternoon, the children will rotate round some activities in their house teams, please go with them and support them. These points will be added together and the team with the most points declared the winner.
- After this the children will return and sit with their class for some track races. Please stay on the parent side of the track for these races and support your children from there.
- At the end of the races, the children will return to their classes to collect their things and then you will be able to
 collect your child from the classroom. As always, if someone different will be collecting your child from the classroom, please let us know.
- In the event of poor weather we will notify you as early as possible and move the event to our reserve date of Friday 5th July.

End of Term Events

Friday 12th July - Your child will bring home their end of year report. These will include SATs results for Year 6, times table results for Year 4 and phonic screening results for year one

<u>Monday 15th July</u> - Teachers will be available at the end of the school day, if you have any questions about your child's report. There are no appointments for this. Just wait at the end of the day if there is anything you wish to clarify or discuss.

<u>Thursday 18th July</u> - Summer house team day. The children will spend the day in their house teams and rotate round the classes where each teacher will have planned a summer themed activity.

<u>Friday 19th July</u> end of year discos. As with previous discos, there will be two sessions - one for Squirrel Class, and one for Fox and Owl Class. A letter will be sent out shortly with more details. Please return the slip and the money to book your child's place.

Monday 22nd July - whole school walk and picnic lunch - We are hoping for fine weather on the last Monday of term for our final whole school walk of the year. When we return to school, we plan on having a picnic lunch together on the field as a school. This will be a rare chance to sit and eat our lunch as a whole school instead of being separated into three rooms. From Tuesday 2nd July If your child is entitled to free school meals or infant free school meals, you can select the packed lunch option for this day, or choose to send your child in with a packed lunch. There will be no option to book a hot meal. Packed lunches need to be ordered by Sunday 7th July.
