Dear Parents and Carers,

School Photos

The photographer will be here on the morning of Wednesday 18th September for individual school photos. If you would like a photograph with pre-school siblings please arrive at 8.30am and these will be taken first. Any siblings in school will be photographed together during the morning. Please ensure your child has a school jumper or cardigan that day as they are photographed against a white background.

Census Day - Thursday 3rd October

Census Day is an important day in the Primary School Calendar as the government uses data gathered on this day to identify the level of funding each school receives.

As parents there are some things you can do to help ensure the school receives the highest level of funding possible.

1. The first is to ensure you have applied for free school meals status if you qualify (even if you don't want the meal or your child is in squirrel class and gets a free school meal). Children entitled to Free School Meals can access free holiday club places and get food vouchers in some of the holidays.

Free School meals are available to pupils in receipt of, or whose parents are in receipt of certain benefits. If you are not sure, it takes moments to apply and at least one parent has tried and discovered their child qualifies. 2. The second is to order a hot school meal for your child. We have an American theme day, with beef burger or macaroni cheese on the menu. Even if children bring in a packed lunch on the day but try a little of each dish, as long as they have an order on ParentPay, we can count them as a meal taken. If you are taking this option please let us know, so that we can ensure they try the meal. Orders must be made on <u>ParentPay by Thursday 19th September</u>.
