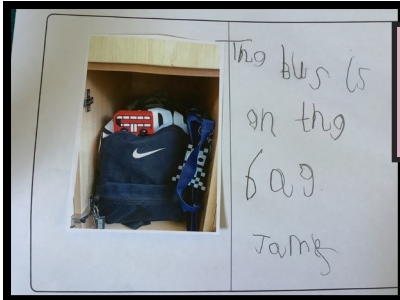

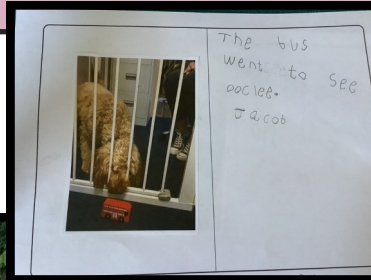
## Some Learning from this week
